### Message from the Pastor



#### **Holy Week**

The next day the great crowd that had come for the Feast heard that Jesus was on his way to Jerusalem. They took palm branches and went out to meet him, shouting, "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessed is the King of Israel!" (John 12:12,13)

This month, the last full week of March is also the last week of Lent, called "Holy Week." On this week we observe Jesus in the last few days of his life, his death, and his burial.

The gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John devote a lot of time in their books to this week. 18% of the gospel of Luke, 25% of Matthew, 31% of Mark and 32% of John cover events of Holy Week, from Jesus' entering Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, through the Sabbath day while Jesus lay in his tomb.

It's for good reason that we have more worship services during Holy Week than any other week of the year. This will be the week to see the great extent of our Lord Jesus' love for us. Here's what to expect when you come:

Palm Sunday, March 24: Palm branches on and by the altar remind us of how the crowd spread palm branches on the path of the Mount of Olives as Jesus rode on a donkey toward Jerusalem. Hymns like "Hosanna, Loud Hosanna," lead us to sing with the crowd to our coming King. May we remember that Jesus is our King—but first he had to humble himself and die to save us from our sins.

Maundy Thursday, March 28: The elements of unleavened bread and grape wine are present before us, part of the last supper Jesus had with his disciples. With these elements Jesus declared he was giving us his body and blood, a new testament given to us for the forgiveness of our sins. Communicants will receive this as a blessing at our 6:30 p.m. service.

On March 28 we will also continue the Lenten series "God on Trial" with the theme "Respite."

Good Friday, March 29: It was about 3 p.m. when Jesus died on the cross. We will have a somber Good Friday service at that hour. You will notice the altar stripped of paraments, signifying God's Son being forsaken by his Father, and dying to save us all. We will conclude the Lenten series "God on Trial" with the theme "Evidence."

We encourage you all to come and worship our Savior during Holy Week. "Come to Calvary's holy mountain, sinners, ruined by the fall; here a pure and healing fountain flows to you, to me, to all, in a full, perpetual tide, opened when our Savior died." (CW #394 v. 1)
