Summer Worship

But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. (2 Peter 3:18a)

Summertime brings many things to mind: Hotter weather, lots of sunshine, vacations and no school—just to start the list. It's a time when many families and individuals have a more relaxed schedule. Many leave town on weekends to camp, go to a ball game, or visit relatives and extended family.

Perhaps Sunday worship isn't foremost on many minds during the summer. There are no big Christian holidays like Christmas and Easter to plan for. Sunday School's out for the summer. Attendance tends to dip in the summer months, not because of bad weather (as might happen in winter), but because of good weather (we've got to get out and enjoy it!).

But worship services do continue in the summer at St. Paul's. God wants this to be a regular, important part of our routine every season, including summer. We need this hour or two with the Lord so that we may keep growing in our faith, getting stronger to face the temptations of the devil and opposition from the world. When you come to church in June, July and August, you will notice the green of the altar cloths. Green is the color for the Sundays after Trinity, the non-festival half of the church year.

The focus in our church services will be on the Christian life and how we may grow in our faith in Christ. Here are our worship themes for the Sundays in June:

June 2 (2nd Sun. after Pentecost): Jesus offers love in place of legalism.

June 9 (3rd Sun. after Pentecost): Jesus brings victory in place of defeat.

June 16 (4th Sun. after Pentecost): The Lord's power in growing his kingdom.

June 23 (5th Sun. after Pentecost): The Lord's power over nature.

June 30 (6th Sun. after Pentecost): The Lord's power over death.

I might see you at the park, the ball game or the fair this summer. But I do expect to see you at church on Sunday mornings. Have a great summer!
